- **KYACAC KEMBERLY D. MERRITT "ACHIEVE YOUR DREAMS SCHOLARSHIP":** Amount \$500. To apply students must sing into their Google Accounts in order to complete application and to see all requirements. - **KENTUCKY FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP:** To Apply: student must have either a minimum of 3.5GPA or minimum 23ACT score. Be the child of a Kentucky Farm Bureau member, finish high school, be enrolled in any accredited college, be a full-time student and maintain a 2.5GPA. **DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 28, 2017** Application can be downloaded at www.kyfb.com/scholarships or application in YSC

- **Young Farmer Scholarship** for college or Votech schools – **Deadline is April 28**
- **Louis F. Ison Memorial Scholarship** for students in Agriculture/Food/Environment – **Deadline is April 28.**
- **Paul D. Everman Scholarship** for non-traditional students – **Deadline is April 28.**
- **Women’s Educational Grant** for non-traditional women- **Deadline is October 21.**

Eligibility: Each Applicant must be graduation high school senior, US citizen, sponsored by a current NTCA Association, accepted by an accredited two or 4-year college, have at least a C GPA, express interest to return to rural community. Instructions: Complete scholarship application in full, 300 word essay on 1/ Describe your most significant accomplishment & explain why you believe it to be your most outstanding, 2, Describe the community in which you live & how it has influenced you, 3. What industry or opportunities would entice you to return to rural community, (grammar & spell-check Important), high school teacher or guidance counselor complete the Educator’s Statement, Submit 1 letter of recommendation from local community leaders, copy of your transcripts, manager sponsoring company endorse your application, EVERYTHING MUST HAVE 2 COPIES. **DEADLINE MARCH 1, 2017** Website: www.frs.org
- ➔ **GEORGE CRAFTON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** Amount \$1000, In order to be consider: Intend to major in the field of Ag or Conservation of natural resources, 2 letters of recommendation, recent transcript, completion of an essay “What I Foresee as the Future of Agriculture and the Important Issues Facing this Industry”, Application must be signed by local conservation district contact, and Application completion. **Deadline: March1, 2017.** Application in YSC, see Ms. Sparks
- ➔ **APPLACHIAN WIRELESS SCHOOLARSHIP:** Amount: \$1000, VISIT www.applachianwireless.com for all information. Guidelines: complete 3 page application, high school transcript, 2.5 GPA & ACT on transcript< 3 letter of recommendation, 2 from school official/teachers, 1 from member of community non-relative, 1 page typed essay entitle, “The reason why I should receive this scholarship and the role it plays in help me achieve my goals.” Application can be found online or YSC. **DEADLINE: MARCH 24, 2017**
- ➔ **PRTC SCHOLARSHIP:** Eligibility: live in PRTC service area, graduating senior, enroll full time in post-secondary institution, financial need, academic achievement, personal essay (details the student’s plans for the future, “What do you want to do with your life, how do plan to utilize your degree”) ,2 letters of recommendation, community involvement, complete application, high school transcript, color photo, with personal information i.e. ACT score, income, rank in class, & GPA. **Application deadline: April 15, 2017.** WEBSITE: www.prtcnet.org
- ➔ **JACKSON CO. FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP:** *Applications* for this scholarship must be picked up at the local JC Farm Bureau office. **Deadline is May 1.**

- ➔ **JACKSON COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT SCHOLARSHIP:** Two \$1,000 scholarships available, Qualifications: seniors who are planning to major in agriculture and agricultural related fields such as forestry, wildlife biology and other environmental related fields. Application in YSC
